

This guide has over 350 pages of information that prepares you for entry into any of the five military services. The 10 chapters include such as chemistry, earth and space science, math, English, electronics, work shop knowledge and there are even two practice tests included. The chapters are like being in a class but you can read at your own speed and even use a highlighter for areas you want to take special note of. You can take the tests and then check the answer sheets. All of this prepares you for the tests you take for entry into any of the five military services. The six-page introduction tells you everything you need to get started using this study guide. Even if you aren't looking to join a military service, this study guide will give you information that you can use in everyday life.

The Armed Forces Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is one of those broad-based tests that covers a lot of ground. Just where to start can be problematic, but there are several books out there that help young people figure out just where to start. For example, there is the familiar ASVAB for Dummies, a book I'd recommend picking up right along with this one. It will give you a good idea where to start, a way to understand the test, and will help with some strategies. As I always maintain, there is no corner on the market for any single test and different guides are a plus. If you are thinking of joining the military, the Trivium is an excellent study guide (test prep) and practice book to consider. The introductory material gives some basic information on the ASVAB, computer adaptive testing, when you can retake the ASVAB (if necessary), what is on the test, a breakdown of subtests, scoring, qualifying scores broken down by service branch, how it is administered, an a blurb about the recruitment process. When I took the test years ago there were no books such as this one to check out. Throughout the book there are small sidebars with icons. These indicate things you should take note of. For example, one explains that "On multiple choice tests, it is often easier to plug the possible values into the equation and determine which solution makes the equation true than to solve the equation." Hints, facts, and cautionary notes are very handy and are a nice addition to the text. There are plenty of illustrations, charts, graphs, and infographics to reference while learning the ropes, so to speak. Of course you have to

have some education in your back pocket because this (or any study guide) is supplementary material. The Trivium will give you the study / prep / practice you need to get your act together. There is information in the introduction that tells me what is on the ASVAB, but each chapter is prefaced with additional information. For example, how many questions there are, how long the test will take, and what the questions cover. There are two full practice tests in this book with answer keys and explanations. I think that if you plan to have a career in the military this is a good place to start. Everyone has to take the ASVAB to determine what position they will have upon entrance into any part of the United States Military. I would want to be fully prepared. This book is broken down into easy to understand sections. It is the best way to prepare for taking the ASVAB. I highly recommend it to anyone interested or entertaining the idea of joining the military. This book would be great for recruiters to be able to share with their recruits. It would also be a helpful tool for guidance counselors and social workers that deal with teens. I feel like it is a good starting point for a conversation towards their future.

This guide is a great tool for her to study and learn what she will be in for when she takes the leap. This is a very comprehensive prep book and covers stuff that you would never think about without prior knowledge. Things have changed since her father entered the military 30 years ago so he really could not help answer her questions about today's testing and scoring of tests. This guide also helps you to learn your strengths and weaknesses so you can improve what you need to before the actual tests. I think this book is going to help her enormously.

This is a really good, comprehensive book. As an instructor I am always looking for study guides to recommend to my students, and I really like this one. It is a good-sized book and includes several sections. It goes into detail in each section with examples and practice questions. What I really like about this book is that it explains the answers. Having a book that gives you the answers is one thing, but if you don't understand HOW they got that answer you are still going to be confused. It has practice tests along with over 200 sample questions, which I think are a great representation of the actual test. I have purchased other books from Trivium and as usual, they nailed it with this one.

There is no "fluff" material in the book, just the straight-forward information you will need.
