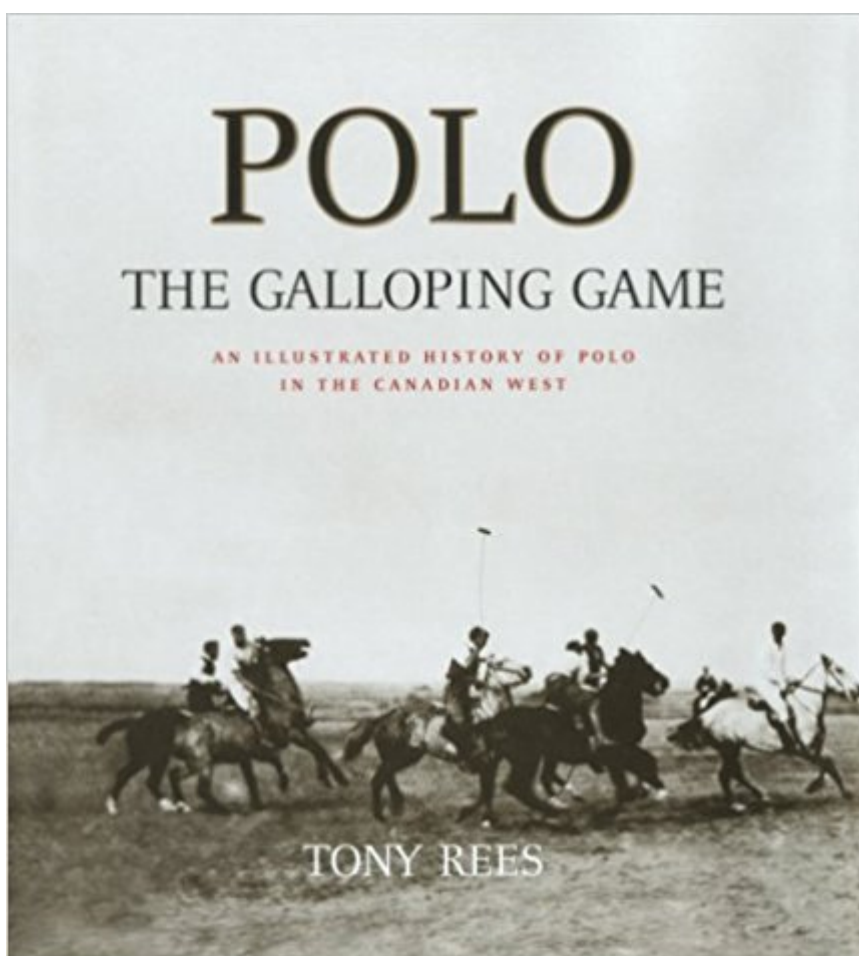




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Polo, The Galloping Game: An Illustrated History Of Polo In The Canadian West
