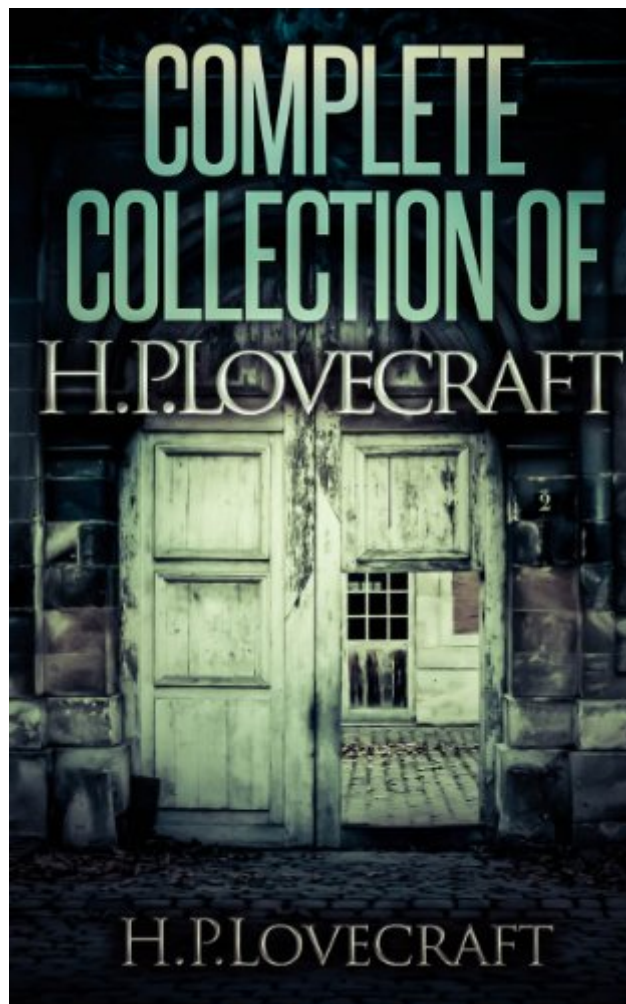

I love me some good HP Lovecraft and all of his works for \$1.99 is awesome. I've relived some of my favorites and with something like 10000 pages this is awesome.

Lovecraft, for me, is a tough but worthwhile read. His writing style is a bit outdated, but the way he builds the worlds his characters live in is unique to him. If you're alive in today's world you owe large chunks of your popular culture experience to Lovecraft, whether you know it or not. Absolutely worth

the read, but not everyone will make it through because the writing is a bit lofty. I, personally, enjoy looking up a word or two every chapter. Others will be put off by this. As far as the quality of the book as a collection, it's beyond question.

OK, Lovecraft is one of those authors that you either love or hate. His stories are dark, always with supernatural element to them, following a somewhat constant theme of cosmic races that somehow found their way into our planet. If you like this mixture of horror, supernatural, and alien life forms, you will like Lovecraft. I like his style - his tales develop in a deliberately slow cadence, where information is delivered in small doses at a very regular pace, which makes it hard to set a story aside once you start it. His English is polished and elegant, not your 8th grade level prose you find in many authors today; personally, I appreciate reading intelligently written, well composed sentences. If you are a dialog kind of person, be aware that there are barely any in his books. Having said that, his descriptions of places, people and monsters are vivid, greatly stimulating your imagination. A few tales are particularly good - "The Dreams in the Witch House" and "At the Mountain of Madness" are the ones I like the best. I have to say, however, that this is not a book to read in one sitting; after some time, the stories and the themes become a bit repetitive; I usually read anywhere between five or ten stories, set the book aside to read something else, and when I'm in the mood, I go back to Lovecraft again.

I must admit that I would never have bought this on kindle if it weren't for the free audio books. I don't have a whole lot of time to read anymore, which is why that addition of audio books is a huge plus for me. Downloading one or two and then listening to them during car rides or while doing menial tasks is great. I'd heard Lovecraft was one of the big names in the horror genre and I'd always wanted to check out some of his stuff, but I just never found the time. This purchase remedies the problem and I was very satisfied. Concerning the works themselves I have to say that H.P Lovecraft is indeed a master of his trade. The stories aren't the gruesome blood and gore like you'd find in the modern horror film, nor are they the mildly moralizing "horror" tales that I've known other authors from older era's to pen. Lovecraft's work is like a creeping feeling crawling up your spine, it's the horror of everything you know being turned on its head in the worst possible way and that's the type of story I can really dig. It's most likely not going to keep you awake at night but it's going to be a ton of fun listening to.

This is an absolutely fantastic collection for any fan of HP Lovecraft. As it states in the title, this is

150 ebooks + links to more than 100 audiobooks for HP Lovecraft's work. This works on Kindles, and even on my iPad's Kindle app. You simply cannot get any better deal than this! For a ridiculously small cost (\$0.99) you get this amazing, and vast digital tome of some of the best sci-fi/cosmic horror. Do yourself a favor and support the fine folks who put this collection together. It should be noted, in case anyone is unclear, or unsure... this is not a tribute collection, but, the actual work by Lovecraft, himself.

The work of H.P. Lovecraft is really a marvel to me; the stories, though sometimes heavy handed, still manage to inspire in me a feeling of abject dread that few works, even in disparate mediums, have failed to evoke. My one qualm with the works of Lovecraft is that at times he tells rather than shows in regards to singular scenes of particular horror. This collection of the stories that Lovecraft is marginally famous for is wonderful in its content (a complete collection), and at an impossibly reasonable price (\$0.99 at the time of my writing). I would recommend picking up the works of Lovecraft and giving them a go; though some may not find his abstract tales to their taste, for the price, I can't recommend enough at least giving them a try.

If you enjoy horror movies, stories, Halloween masks, art, etc. and you have not read Lovecraft yet, put it at the top of your To Do list. All the greatest contemporary horror authors, and authors since the 1950's, have been influenced by and enjoyed this work.. Some of the stories are, to put it mildly, a tad PLODDING yet the PLOTTING is not to be beat. (Except maybe from a cat-o-nine-tails.) From Stephen King to South Park, all those in-the-know... know Lovecraft's work. Enjoy. Mwa ha ha! (Evil laugh.)

Has some pretty obvious missprints and typeset issues. At some points it reads like a badly scanned PDF. Nice portable volume of Lovecraft however!
