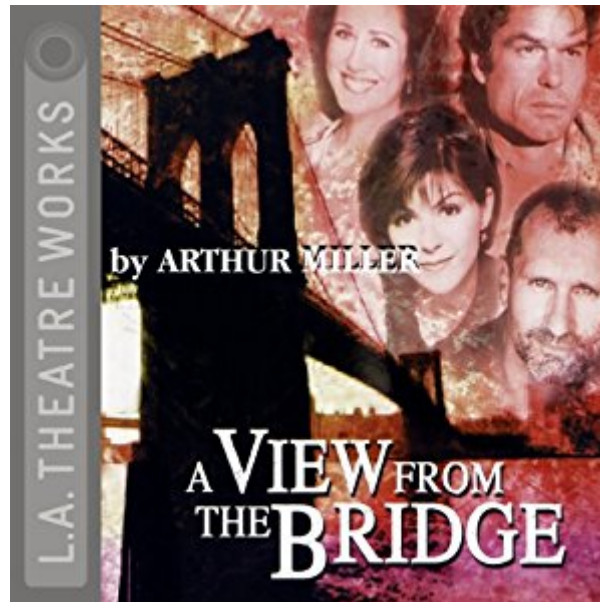

For instance, in 'The Crucible' -- who am I to argue that he did not get facts and social mores correct as to that era centuries ago. This work, however is more recent, takes place during his lifetime and could actually take place yesterday or today. Both the main issue/conflict and an ancillary issue/conflict are pertinent modern issues. I think this was revived on Broadway during the past year and I would have liked to see if the set-up was modern or did they use that setting described in the play. This

work is thought provoking as heck.
