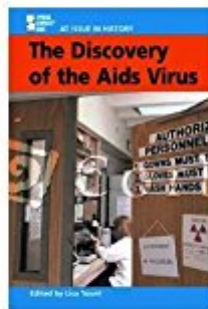




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# **At Issue In History - Discovery Of The AIDS Virus (hardcover Edition)**
