There are really only 2 little negatives about the book.1- its a complex story with a lot of world and character building. Its been at least a few months since I read the other two, so I had forgotten quite a bit. The author did provide a character recap in the beginning of the book, which was nice.2- It was too short! :) It wasn't novella short but it didn't seem as long as the first two, and when the story is good you want a good long book. That didn't detract in any way from the story though!

Finally, we see Claire gain some maturity and star dealing with her problems. If only she could get over Thanos and their insta-love failure. At some point she has to stand on her own and not need a man in the wings.

I really enjoyed this installment of the Devils assistant Series. As always, the world building was excellent. The characters are developing in very interesting ways and the story is very engaging.
