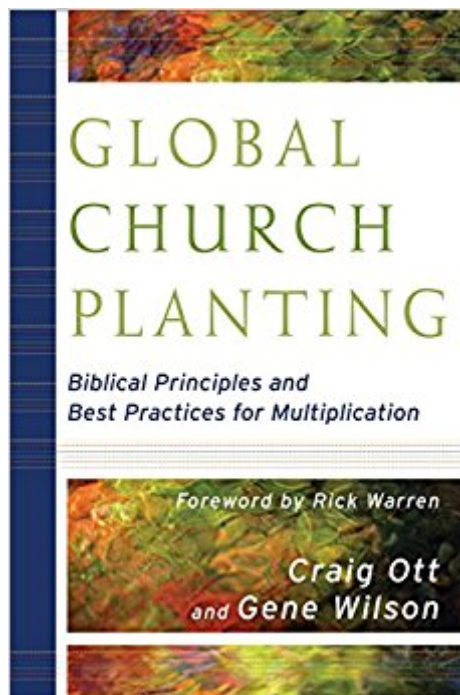




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Global Church Planting: Biblical Principles And Best Practices For Multiplication

Craig Ott (PhD, Trinity Evangelical Divinity School) is professor of mission and intercultural studies at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School in Deerfield, Illinois, where he occupies the ReachGlobal Chair of Mission. He is the coauthor of *Encountering Theology of Mission* and coeditor of *Globalizing Theology*. Gene Wilson (DMin, Westminster Theological Seminary) is church planting director for ReachGlobal, the international mission of the Evangelical Free Church of America, and director of their annual Cross-Cultural Church Planting School. He served as a church planter in Canada for eighteen years and a church planting trainer and coach in Latin America and the Caribbean for eight years.

I've been a missionary to Swaziland, Africa for 8 years, and we just started planting churches this year. I got my hands on a lot of books and resources on planting churches, but this one is my most prized resource. Each time I open the pages, I find myself highlighting, underlining, and quickly applying the concepts and practical steps for missions and outreach in rural Swaziland. The authors

do an excellent job at explaining the essence of the church, despite cultural and government differences, and how to pursue building a church in a biblical way. Here is a church planting book par excellence. There is a proliferation of books on church planting compared to when I first went into church planting. Some of these books are valuable in one area - such as planting a church by the team approach or detailing some important ministry in church planting. However, this book is fully-orbed because it cares for (as the title indicates) both biblical principles and best practices. In this it is similar the great classic on church planting by David Hesselgrave *Planting Churches Cross-Culturally* in that it respects the biblical agenda. However, it is different in that Hesselgrave's book uses the Pauline cycle as found in Acts. Ott and Wilson use what they call "Developmental Phases" (Part III). But both approaches have value and I would encourage the study of both of these. The book is in four major parts starting with the biblical base and then moving on to strategy and phases in church planting. The fourth part deals with five critical issues. The "Parable of the Apple Trees" found in the Prologue is a fascinating start to this valuable book. Read it and use it if you teach church planting or are involved in church planting. It is to be regretted that there are no exercises at the end of each chapter to help apply the material. If this book is used by a church planting team or in a course, this need would need to be dealt with. The only other question

is the size of the book. This is both a help as it enables one to deal with all the major questions but a starting church planter may find it overwhelming. I found this book so helpful that I purchased an additional copy and sent it off to a school in Ilesa, Nigeria, that has asked for help. Maybe you should do the same for some church planter or school.
