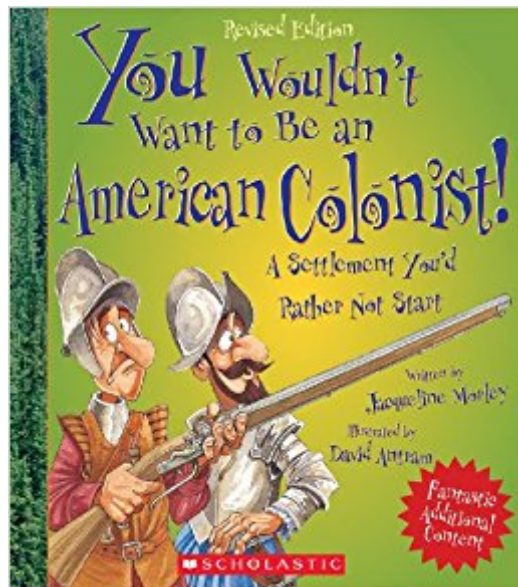




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# You Wouldn't Want To Be An American Colonist!
