

Previously, she teamed up with illustrator Gijsbert van Frankenhuyzen on the award-winning *Legend* series, including *The Legend of the Lady's Slipper* (Upper Midwest Bookseller's Favorite). *B is for Badger* is her fourth state alphabet book. She lives with her family in Petoskey, Michigan. Renee Graef is new to the Sleeping Bear Press family but is very well known as a children's book illustrator for the American Girls collection with Pleasant Company. She has also illustrated for Boyd's Bears and is the illustrator of HarperCollin's *My First Little House* series. Renee attended the University of Wisconsin and the University of Madison; she lives in Milwaukee with her family.
