

Product reviewed: Don Quijote de la Mancha (Spanish Edition), Lavla Edizioni - streetlib version. I like three things about this edition: 1) The price. At \$2.99 it's a good deal if you're looking for the complete Quijote in electrons. 2) It's the complete version, including both books I & II plus the introductory material. 3) Display and navigation. Although the text is justified, words hyphenate as needed for an even display across the eBook screen. If you don't need footnotes and just want to read the original Spanish text, it would be hard to find a better edition of the Quijote in electrons. My only complaint against the book: the long paragraphs. This was the style back in the day of Cervantes when books were expensive and the reader expected every page to be filled with text. In our day, and particularly in an eBook, this type of paragraph is hard to follow. It wouldn't violate the original text to insert carriage returns to make reading the book a little easier. Device used: Kindle Paper White.

I bought this book for my middle school native and advanced Spanish speakers. This is one of my favorite books and it is definitely written at a middle school level. There are some words that are

annotated, per chapter, and it helps students understand what they're reading. It also helps to teach the preterite vs. imperfect.
