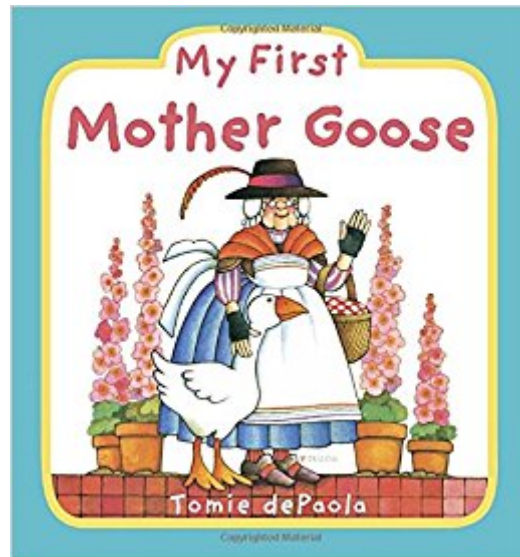




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My First Mother Goose

I got this book for our 2 month old, now 3 months old, and he loves it! The illustrations are of real people (not all animals like some other Mother Goose books) and totally captivating. I wasn't sure the baby would even be into this but I am so pleased at how much he enjoys it. His favorite is Baa Baa Black Sheep, and he actually smiles and now laughs. We read this book at least once a day. Total hit!!

The board pages are excellent for toddlers who often tear pages apart. This pages are hard enough for avoiding that. The book has also nice pictures. As a "My first..." this book might be a little short for people that is looking for more Mother Goose's stories, but it's a good start.

Our 21mo old son loved the First Songs book, which I originally checked out from the local library and then purchased for him. I thought he'd also enjoy this Mother Goose book by the same author, but it doesn't seem to hold his attention. Maybe he's too young? If you're going between the two, I'd get the First Songs instead.
