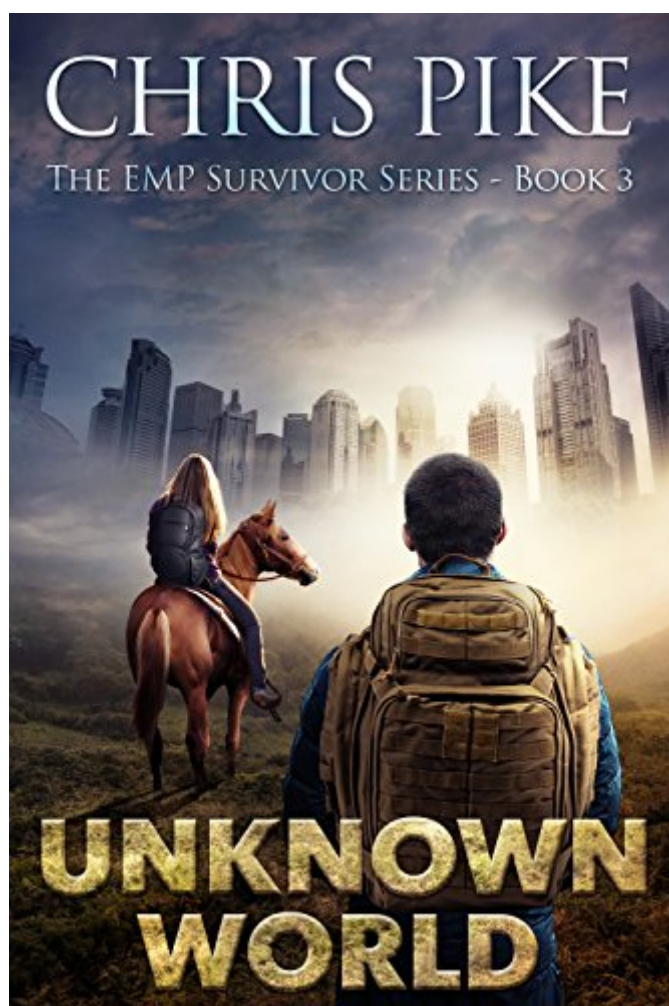


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Unknown World: A Post Apocalyptic/Dystopian Survival Fiction Series (The EMP Survivor Series Book 3)

Book number three of three book post apocalyptic series. I read the nicely formatted and printed POD (print on demand) version in trade paperback. The author has plans to publish the 4th book in the series this year and the 5th book in 2018. All of the books so far are a quick read since they are around 220 pages long, in fact the author states that her book length target is around 200 pages to keep things moving along. For the second time that I have noticed, the author has credited an editor person, a formatter person, and a cover art person for this self published book. Interesting, I liked the attributions. An unexplained EMP happens to the USA in the southern region along the Gulf Coast. The book does not tell what happens to the rest of the USA. As with all EMP books, the damage is extreme, affecting all automobiles, computers, electrical grids, etc, etc, etc. And airplanes. This book is about two new protagonists returning home to the north Austin area several months after the EMP. Texas has suddenly become a very dangerous area to travel in. I enjoyed the book very much, especially since it is set in Texas where I live and in Louisiana. However, I disagree with the author that an EMP over the USA will kill car computers. Regular computers wired to the grid, yes. But car computers live in the horrible environment of automobiles with under-voltage, over-voltage, current spikes, etc, etc, etc. Cars will probably survive the EMP but your electrical grid, not.

As indicated in reviews of books 1 and 2, the story, author's skills, story-line, characters and overall continuing story has created high interest, high expectations and confidence that the next book will be the hot topic and page-turner high quality work that the two previous books are. I love this genre, have rated a few in the 5 category and many in the 4 category. This author is top of the line. I even requested an email notification for book 4!!

Chris Pike has fashioned another dystopian thriller; this time with a beautiful girl, a dog, a horse, and a man with the gumption to strap on dangerous weapons and an equally daunting adventure. An EMP has changed the world. No one can be trusted. And, the mobs ahead are determined to prove that "you can't go home again." For the young Lone Star lovers, trying to get from East Texas to Austin may require more guns and rounds than are available. There are enemies ahead who want Amanda and Chandler- dead. A novel so well crafted with action and artful detail that the real surprise is that this journey will be equally thrilling for man or woman. Enjoy. I surely did~
