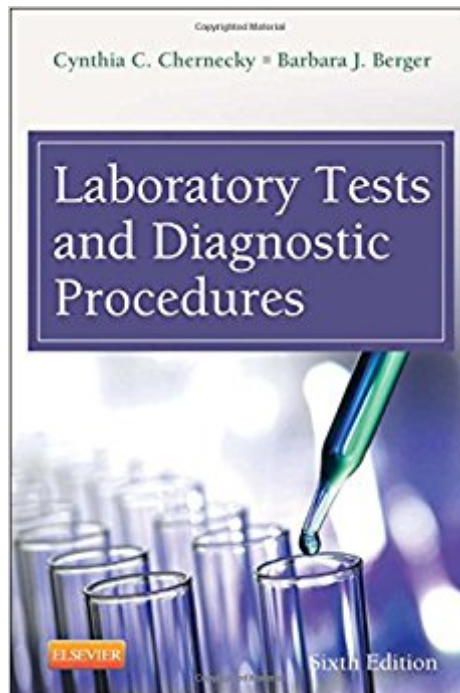

The table of contents is incomplete, so if you need to reference something during the clinical setting be prepared to flip through each individual page. It takes too much time. (Chapters are in alphabetical order by condition, and it ends at the letter F).
