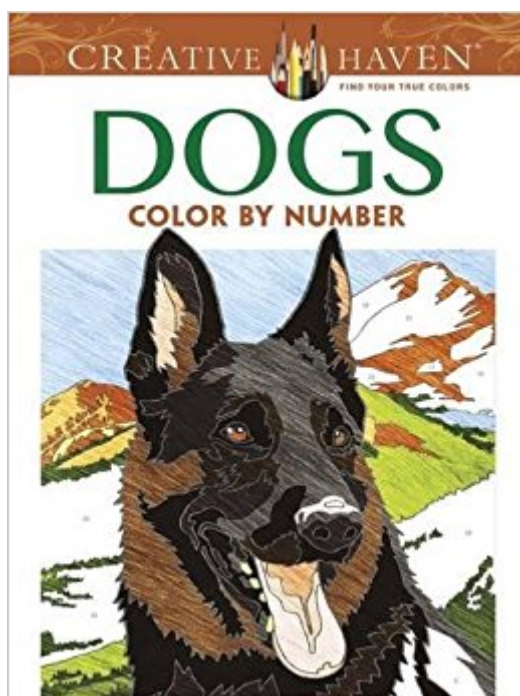

This is a very cute coloring book for cat and dog lovers. The designs are of cats and dogs together or separately. It makes for a nice variety of designs. The drawings have a nice level of detail with good backgrounds as well. A number of animal books I own are of just the animal without any form of background. In these designs, the backgrounds are both inside and outside. The animals have a nice level of detail as well but leave plenty of room for adding your own finishing touches. You can choose make them a single color or to change it up a bit and make them multiple colors. I like the freedom this provides while I am coloring the designs. What I did miss was the framing line that most Creative Haven coloring books have on the outer edges of the designs. It made it more difficult to have a nicely finished project. Otherwise, I really liked the designs in the book. I decided to do a design of a kitten and a puppy snuggling in sleep as my first project. I had fun using my oil-based pencils and adding fur to the animals. I'll post a photo of my first project as well as samples from the book. This is what I saw while coloring in this book and testing the paper with my coloring medium. I will list, in the comments section below, the coloring medium I use for testing and for coloring.

31 Cat and Dog designs – some with cats and dogs together and some where they are shown separately. The designs are printed one side of the page. Paper is the usual Creative Haven quality: white, medium weight, slightly smooth and has perforated pages. Glue Binding but with perforated pages so removing a page is fairly simple. The designs stop well before the perforations. Alcohol-based markers bleed through this paper. Water-based markers bleed through in spots and show colorful shadows on the back of the page. Gel pens and India ink pens leave shadows of color on the back of the page. India ink pens can bleed through when I apply more than one layer of ink. Coloring pencils work well with this paper. I was able to get good color, layer the same color and multiple colors and blend easily using a pencil style blender. I tested both oil and wax-based pencils with similar results. Hard lead pencils, like Verithins, leave dents on the back of the page. I suggest either removing pages from the book to color or using a blotter page under your working page. I like card stock as it keeps ink from seeping through and damaging the pages below.

I know that the book is all dogs but if you want a book with colors, this is not the one. I love Creative Haven color by numbers but this one was just boring to me even just looking at the colors needed (which consist of LOTS of brown & black). If you want colorful, bright pictures...look up their other Color by Number options.

I like the pictures but they all look like they need a border of some sort. A couple almost run off the page. The good news is that none are too close to the spine. As usual the pages are perforated so they can be removed. I haven't decided if I like the author's drawing style. A lot of the pictures have an unfinished look. That is why I gave it four instead of five stars. Maybe once I start coloring I will like it more.

so disappointed. if you want to use crayons you will like this. i did not buy this for the color coding (which is awful) but for the love of dogs. pics have very large spaces to color, reminds me of the children's paint by number pics. i use it for youngish children to color.

I like this coloring book the only draw back is that the numbers show through the lighter colors, I found that a bit of gouache white paint covers the numbers and colored pencil does stick to it, unlike White Out.

Love the Creative Haven Color by Number by this author. If you have the Color by Number Wildlife book, the first 20 colors are identical to that book. So if you have matched those colors it can make it easier for this book. There are no color names in the key, and there are 10 browns but if you use Prismacolor pencils or a combination of these and Blics pencils you can get the right combination. You can also buy these pencils individually (I have bought Prismacolor individuals at Michaels and Hobby lobby) to avoid the expense of buying a whole set. Have not finished a dog picture in this book, but I bought 2 books as I love dogs and the Wildlife pictures turned out gorgeous when done. Even if you don't get the colors matched exactly the pictures look great. These are fun to do when you love to do nature or animal pictures realistically but would not have a clue how to choose the colors yourself to make them look good. Only issue I have is my books came dented at edges? not sure why, but it won't affect pictures for me:)

Very cute, detail isn't too advanced so it works well as a older child's coloring book and an adult's, wish there was more variety in pictures. The cats and dogs are very similar. Still cute I am enjoying it greatly and even my mother who's eyes are no longer perfect can color with ease.

Very nice pictures of cats and dogs, individually and together. I love all the Creative Haven adult coloring books, as the pages are perforated and removable for ease of use. Highly recommended if you are a pet lover!

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
