

Am I small? is the world's first World Children's Book - available for every country on earth in at least one official language.

The art work is excellent but the choice of words is odd. The words used are a weird mix of literary and colloquial words. For a native Hindi speaker it just seems odd to read sentences in this book. Seems like the author does not have a good grasp of which words are literary and which ones are colloquial. I would stick to either of the two approaches and not mix them.

Such a sweet book! The illustrations are gorgeous and the story is fantastic. Does a great job teaching lessons about scale and size as well as perception. Would prefer it in a hard copy though.

This is my 1-year-old's favourite Hindi book and it's probably my favourite too. The Hindi is simple and repetitive and when conjunct consonants are used, the word is first printed with the consonants separately and then in subsequent appearances with the conjunct consonants (useful for me because I don't know them all). The message of the story is great. Tamiya is a very confident girl until she is told by the narrator that she is small - she can't believe what she's hearing ("Me? Small?"). She then goes around asking various creatures whether she is small or big or whatever. She receives vastly different answers depending on the size of the creature she asks (the ladybird thinks she's very big, the Moon thinks she's minuscule). She then realises that size is relative ("I'm everything - big, small, etc") and that actually she's just right as she is. All the creatures agree. Probably the best thing about the book is amazingly imaginative and detailed illustrations. Children can stare at them for ages looking at all the strange little fantastical creatures lurking in corners. The only thing I didn't like was on one page the speech bubbles are laid out in an irrational way so that you might not read the right one first, and also in a couple of places the font is a bit too small (particularly for old people reading to grandkids), because the font size changes depending on

the size of whoever's talking. This book is fun for young children and also for adults learning Hindi.
