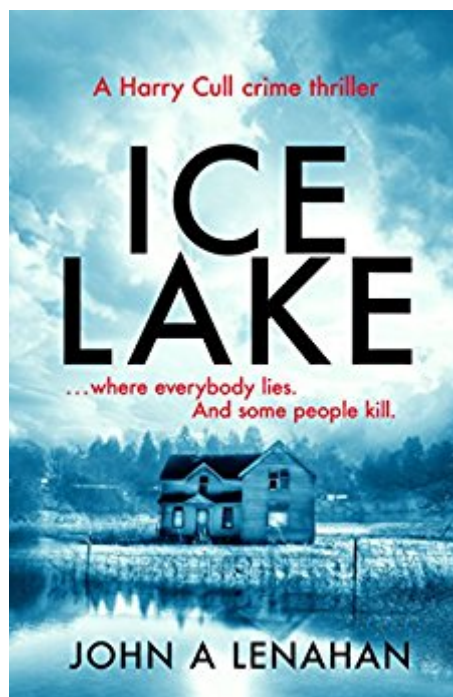

This was billed as "gripping," but I didn't find it so. That said, it was a good introduction to a very likable main character, Harry Cull. He has an unusual side to his psychology practice in that he finds

liars for clients, using a doctored lie detector and an eye for a "tell" when someone is not telling the truth. Generally, he ferrets out what he terms "thin cats for the fat cats," in other words embezzlers. This time he is a consultant to the Pennsylvania State Police, summoned by an acquaintance he made while speaking at a police convention. State Trooper Cirba is enmeshed in a murder at idyllic Ice Lake and is hopeful that Harry can help to find the person who killed Big Bill, a young man just now coming into his own in life. That murder and the ones that follow don't ratchet up the suspense as much as give Harry a reason to stay at the Ice Lake cottage, pursue a love interest, and give the reader a longer, better glimpse into what makes Harry tick. The tone of this book is really good, somewhat sardonic, and editing and proofing were spot on. It's the characters that held my interest, not the story, so I will look forward to visiting Harry and whoever he teams up with as this series continues. The end of this particular tale seemed cobbled together and not quite believable, and for that, I might have taken away a half-star if that were possible.

I could not stay with this book. I tried but only could get through half. Then I skimmed to see if it got better but it just wasn't my style. It was a lot of dialogue between Cull and his cohort that was supposed to just be amusing banter. The "mystery" itself of who shot Big Bill was kind of a sideline to their strip club visits and romance with a local. I didn't care who killed Big Bill from the beginning, and since the protagonists were obnoxious to me, I had to give up. I can see where some might find them funny, but I did not.

I loved the characters and found it to be very informative as well. I hope there is a follow-up to this novel. I'm definitely a fan.
