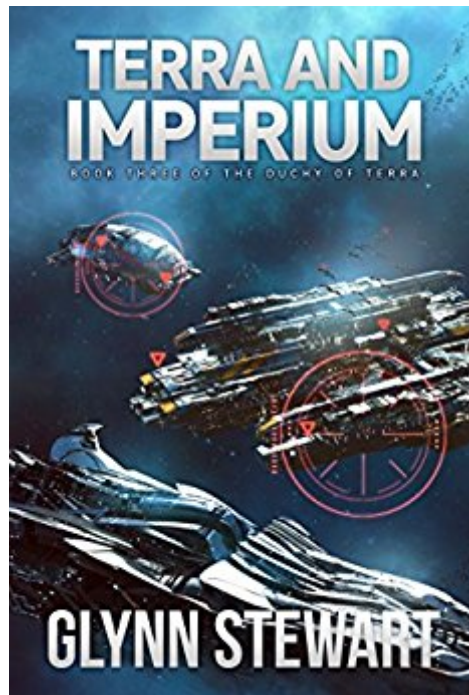

Duchess Annette Bond and the Duchy of Terra have established a Terran colony, Hope, at Alpha

Centauri. The colony planet hides a secret that only the Core Civilizations know about - and they want it badly. Annette has to deal with multiple Core Civilizations, in order to keep Terra and Hope alive and well. The Imperium will try to help - but some Imperials are less helpful than others. Annette is up to her neck in problems she doesn't know anything about - not that this is new to her. Maybe she'll learn something about history that no one else not from the Core knows? As usual, Glynn's writing is only workmanlike - he's not going to win any awards for the quality of his prose. His storytelling is a different matter - this is yet another of his books that kept me up WAY later than was a good for me when I needed to go to work the next morning! I received an Advanced Readers Copy of this book in exchange for an unbiased review. And I have just purchased a copy of the e-book to support Glynn.

Excellent book, well written, good plot, good (and well foreshadowed) character development. I would downgrade it to 4.5 stars maybe, because of some typos, but meh. It's an excellent book! If you liked the first two, get this one. It has a focus of a couple different characters than the first two. They are, as is typical for Glynn Stewart, well written. Again, as you typically notice with his characters, they have distinct voices with distinct personalities that come out well even in a relatively short book you can read in a day or two. :) I recommend you buy. This is better than most Glynn Stewart and better than the DT1 and DT2 books but not quite up to the starship's mage book 1 and 2 plots. But close. Enjoy it! He writes well and writes fast

However an attack on the Duchy's first colony world by what appears to be Kanzi raiders leads to the discovery of a wreck of an incredibly advanced ship from an ancient civilization. Now several more Core Worlds have sent battle groups willing to kill each other and destroy the colony to deny that technology to anyone else. Annette makes new friends and garners the respect of some of battling

entities, even forging an alliance with the Mesharom, the oldest and most reclusive of the Core species. The Duchess must make the correct decisions not only for herself and her child but for the entire AITol Imperium. The Duchy of Terra is one of my favorite series from Glynn Stewart and I will have to admit that writing an "unbiased" review is hard since I have loved all his series. Please keep on entertaining me and thank you for many hours of enjoyment.

What can you say about Bond? Annette Bond. She's the consummate leader, politician, and the Duchess of Terra. This book, the end of the trilogy, involves the Duchy and the Imperium, to which it is bound, in a battle against the core races where Bond must do everything in her power to protect her people and a mysterious artifact of the progenitors against superior technology and might. A literal Tour de Force. If you've read the first two books, this one is not to be missed for Glynn Stewart writes exciting space opera with great characters and fascinating plots. There are still enough loose ends for at least another trilogy and I'm really looking forward to it.

In past novels in the series, Terra has been taken over by aliens, and an earth native appointed as "Duchess" to rule over this section of the galaxy. Terra is in a pretty remote corner of the known universe, and has established her first colony. But suddenly there are visitors from unknown locations threatening the colony, and with advanced technology that we haven't seen before. Terra's corner of the galaxy is getting crowded, as different groups come in search of... something? A great story, with twists and suspense all the way until the end... Loved it!

To begin with it is required that I state that I am an advanced reader for Mr. Stewart. I received an advanced copy in order to provide an early review. However, I also must point out that I have also purchased a copy. I count Mr. Stewart as one of my favorite authors. His writing is top notch and his stories are extremely entertaining.
