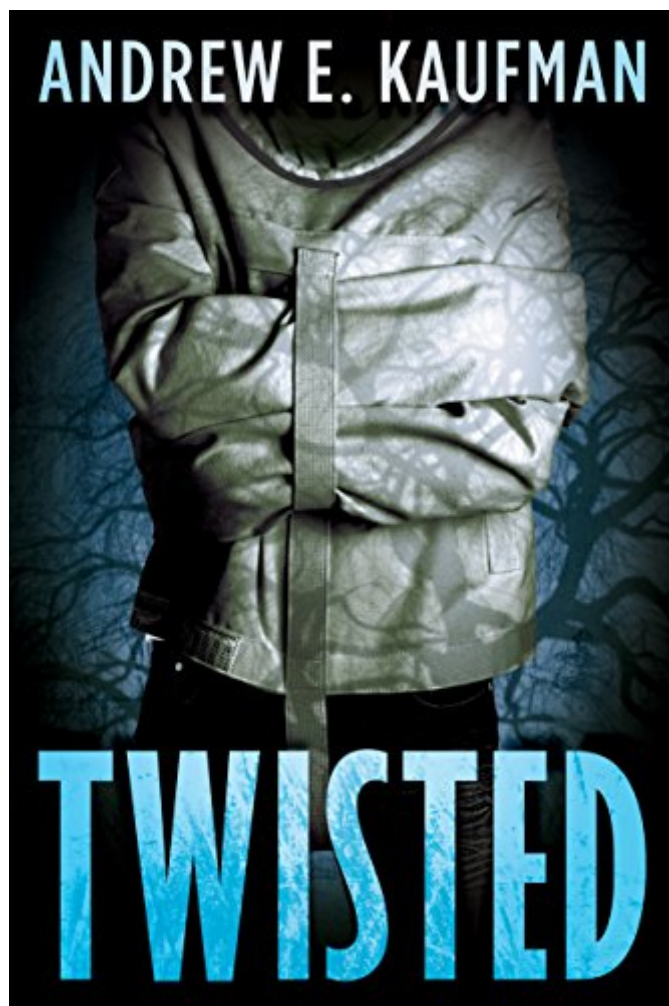

Twisted is a roller coaster ride for the mind. I never saw the next sharp curve or major drop coming as the intensity heightened from page to page, chapter to chapter. Dr. Christopher Kellan is assigned to delve into the mind of a new patient, Donny Ray Smith, suspected serial killer. From the first paragraph, until The End, Andrew E. Kaufman weaved and twisted his characters and their story in an amazing direction. I only know that with each page I found myself wanting more and Mr. Kaufman did NOT disappoint. I was fortunate to win a pre-released Kindle copy of Twisted. Once I began reading, stopping was out of the question. I finished the novel at 3:00am this past Saturday morning. I actually had to stop and take a breath. I found Twisted completely captivating. A psychological thriller at its finest.

I chose 4 stars because Twisted was an absolute mystery down to the last few chapters. It was a page turner, very hard to put down. The book is easy to get into. I also appreciate how Andrew Kaufman knows how to write a great book, without every other word being the *F* word. Yes, it was in there a few times, but did not get offensive. I also appreciate the love that Christopher and his wife had for each other, obvious by a look, a touch of their hands, a hug...but didn't get dirty. 'Love' is not solely a romp in the hay. The love they have for each other is evident the entire book. My favorite books and movies are ones like Twisted that keep you guessing to the very end. I love unexpected endings. I thought the title was referring to the many twisted things in the book, but now I am thinking it has more to do with the amazing twist at the end.

This story is poorly written and contrived. It feels like the author is trying to convince you that the story is interesting and unique instead of telling the story. It tries to be interesting by being outrageous and over the top. It seems that the author is begging you to be convinced that it's a good story.....but it's not.

I really enjoyed this book. The author does an excellent job of weaving in and out of the main characters reality. In addition he really shows you what it's like to loose your mind. And the strength needed to find your way out. Very well done.

This book was a real page turner. It had me hooked within the first few pages. Intensely suspenseful and then it kind of fizzles at the end. Has a surprising "love conquers all" element. Christopher has five days to complete his review and determine if Donny Ray is pure evil or a victim of a tortured past. As Christopher sets to his task the charming, dark and mysterious Donny Ray begins to infiltrate the doctor's mind. Christopher's entire life begins to unravel as the reality he knows slowly slips away.

This story plodded along. The author attempted to create a twisted, psychological thriller, but all he did was write a book that made me scream "get on with it!" The first third of the book laid the ground work of what I thought was going to be a really "twisted" story, but then it just babbled along with the intensity of a mud puddle. I can't believe readers posted such rave reviews about this book. It was a waste of time and money for me, but obviously others enjoy it.
