

This will help you get acquainted with the tool bar, menu's etc. But mostly by name and a very brief explanation of what they can do. This book will also teach/show you short cuts for different tools and menu options. This is an OK start for someone who does not have a clue (me) about Photoshop. I do think it's important to at least know what you're looking at when you open Photoshop and this book will tell you.

this is the type of book that would never sell in a physical bookstore. It is printed on Eastern European toilet paper, the illustrations are laughably illegible, and the whole thing has the appeal of something you pick up for 50 cents at some back-alley copy-shop in a third world country. DO NOT BUY THIS BOOK.

John Slavio may now have me hooked on his books. I was a psychology major in college and have always loved how people think, and have been drawn to many writers in how they view and explain things. I've always loved learning knew things and the way things work. I just read John Slavio's other book called Photoshop for Photographers and was drawn into the way he wrote and explained things, in a way that I truly couldn't stop reading until the end because I became not only fascinated by content, but emerged in the writers way with words. I read John's previous book and this one for one main reason other then realizing I liked his writing style after his first book. I searched out information and came to these books where I found everything that I was looking for. I love reviewing products that I like or sometimes want to warn others about (not necessarily meaning this book, but in general). For example I bought the Ninja coffee bar last yr and loved it because it was so much better then my old, weak, not strong tasting Kurieg and I "NEEDED" to tell others that were also unhappy with the strength of their Kuriegs about just how great this coffee maker was. I bought my Ninja on so I immediately started writing my review on it on 's site, pausing to take additional photos of the carafe and items that came with it as I progressed in my one page review. I submitted it and looked back at my review recently which had been about a year since I wrote it. I noticed it had received over 200 helpful votes and about 10 people didn't find it helpful or hot tired reading it all lol. This "MADE" me looked at reviews for purchases that I also bought around the same time last yr and not many had been found helpful at all or even viewed perhaps. My analytical mind wheels started spinning full force. I thought was it because of popularity that the coffee pot was liked more, was it due to pricing, the review wording, what made people "SEE" it as helpful more?! THEN it hit me like a ton of bricks, it was the pictures, the closeups and numerous photos combined with my words in the review. My review stood out due to photography. After realizing this I started searching for books that would help me take better photos (Johns last book, photoshop for photographers) and read it amazed by the little things that could be done to enhance my photos. After reading these tricks and tips I wanted to know more about the specifics of photoshop programs and the ins and outs and how to's after finding myself emersed in the the techniques of actual photography itself. That led me to his second book here. This book had taught me tips and tricks on the actual editing

(photoshopping) of the photos that I have now been taking in better quality after reading his previous book .In this book not only are there instructions but there are actual photos with arrows showing you exactly what you need to do to from the operations, edits, layering to the actual hot keys (keyboard shortcuts). how to create and edit images, and how to add effects to make your pictures amazing. It teaches you some letting YOU make the edits you want to make to your pictures. It teaches you about lighting and shows you how to adjust and edit it as well as background fading or blurring to make your main subject stand out as the true focal point that it should be in your pictures. Along with coding, I'm interested in photoshopping, so I was intrigued when I saw this Guide to Photoshop ebook. It's turned out to be very helpful and an excellent way to start me on learning photoshopping. It covers the different versions of Photoshop, so it is applicable no matter if you have CC or CS6, this guide can help you. Rightly titled The Ultimate BeginnersÃ¢Â™ Guide to Mastering Adobe Photoshop in 1 Week, this helpful little ebook will give you everything you need to know about Photoshop tools. With its instruction, you will quickly go from absolute beginner to skilled user, along the way learning basic Photoshop operations, layers, Photoshop shortcuts, how to create and edit images, and how to add effects to make your pictures amazing. It gives a detailed explanation of the program interface as well as each of the features of Photoshop. It is also full of helpful suggestions, such as tips on editing pictures, blurring backgrounds, contrasting backgrounds with people, and varying light and color intensity. I have only one suggestion for improvement, and that is that the line spacing is very wide and the text is a little big. This makes the book take up about twice as many pages as necessary, requires me to scroll or swipe unnecessarily, and makes it harder to focus on the words. Other than this, the ebook is a well-written guide, breaks things down simply, and is great for absolute beginners. Instead of reading online Photoshop tutorials which may be inaccurate or vague, you can get this helpful, easy and cheap ebook. An excellent book to help beginners learn to #photoshop!

I was looking for a book to get me started in Photoshop. This is a beginner's guide, but I wouldn't call it the "ULTIMATE" beginner's guide. That's really overselling it. This walks you through the main menus and toolbars. It describes some of the functions of photoshop. It explains what layers are and how to change their order (although I didn't learn how to group or flatten layers or anything like that). It includes a very short list of keyboard shortcuts. This is a very, very short book. I read it in ~1 hour, and I did learn one or two useful things, such as the notion that the tool bar is roughly broken into a few functional sections: selection tools/ pixel editing tools/ text & vector tools/ and navigation tools. I hadn't seen that explained anywhere else. Of course, I am a beginner with Photoshop, so maybe that is obvious to someone who has been using it longer, but I was glad to learn that from this book. Otherwise I didn't get a ton out of this book. I'd recommend you buy it only if you are an ABSOLUTE beginner, and you plan to buy a book that covers a lot more as soon as you finish this one.
