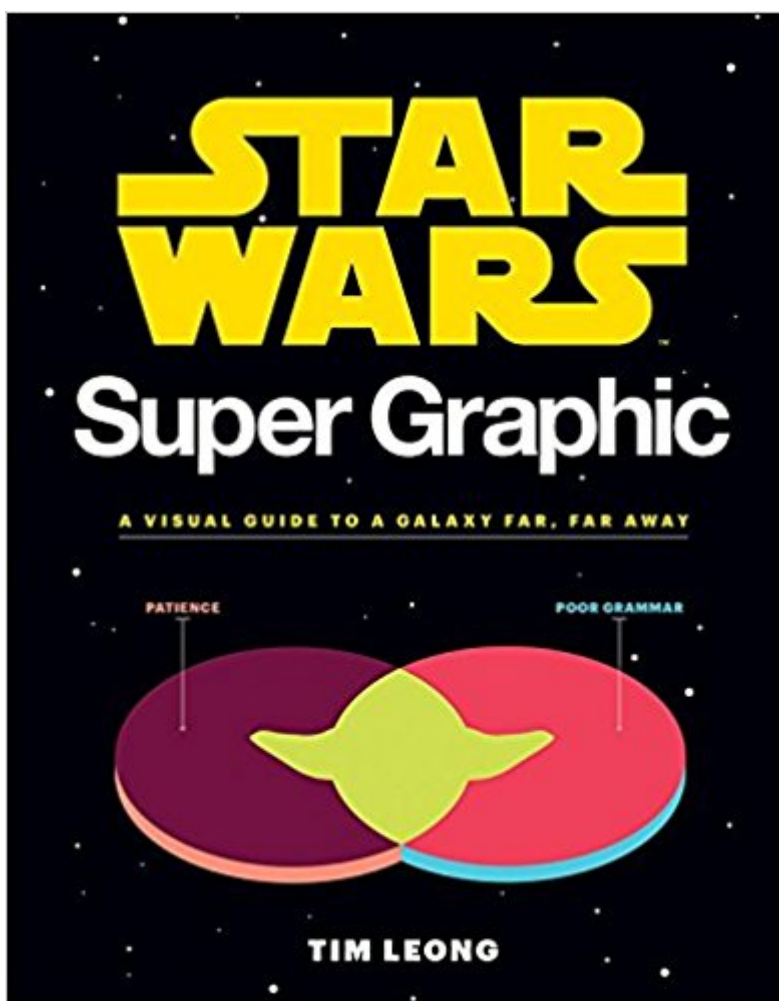


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Star Wars Super Graphic: A Visual Guide To A Galaxy Far, Far Away

Great read.

This is in regards to the digital edition (although I don't see how it could be much better in the print). The charts are simply too large, and the font too small. This is by far one of the worst laid out info-graphic books I have seen. The images are 2388x1524, with a font size of like 12 at that resolution, and some sort of horizontally compressed font too. This would have gotten an F where I studied graphic design... In order to see the font, you have to zoom in so much that half the charts

go off the screen, which defies the purpose when trying to visually compare bar charts. You have to scroll left and right, up and down like a madman. You zoom in to see what each bar chart says, then you have to zoom back out to see how it compares to others. I have this full-screened on a laptop (720p resolution), measuring 15 inches accross and I still can't see these charts properly. No, I do not have pooht, ther eyesigy're just that terrible. Some of the charts are ok, actually, but most are basically unusable. Didn't even try it on a 6 inch kindle screen, god forbid...

KINDLE BUYERS BEWARE! I was very excited to purchase this book, given its wittiness so I bought the Kindle edition. However, the digital edition is very POOR quality. The graphics are small and take up only a fraction of the page. Worst of all, there is no way to zoom in. Highly disappointed. You may have better luck with the paperback version.

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
