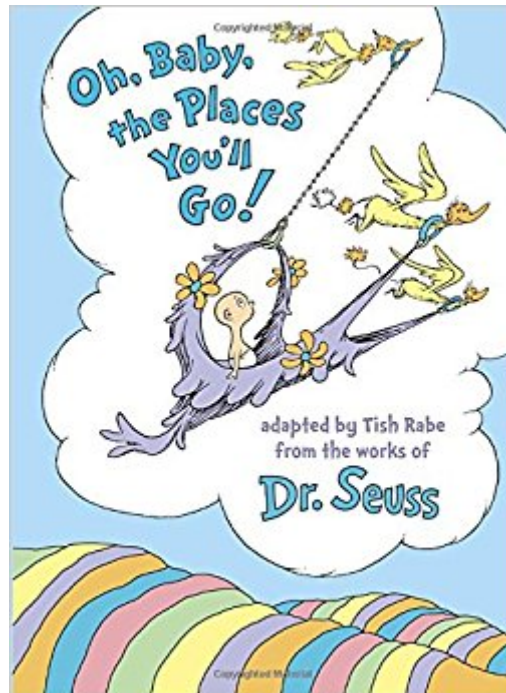

Someone bought us a copy of this book for our baby shower, and I remember reading it a lot and crying over how sweet it was (woohoo pregnancy hormones!). So when our good friend announced they were expecting, I bought it immediately to add to their shower gift. It's a great little book, with a sweet message and a pretty clever intro to all the wonderful characters of Dr. Seuss. My now-two-year-old and I still read this book often and he gets excited and points to all the characters from his other books, so it's a book you can keep reading for a long time.

I'm going to be honest, it was a nice attempt but didn't cut it in my opinion. The book is still the miniature version and it is a lot like "Oh, the places you will go," but borrows from as many Dr. Seuss books as a person can think of with very little original thought put into it. I can't be too harsh and give it less, but if you want to find something to read for the little one whose on their way that moves you, then it lacks a bit. I could have just read my daughter "Oh, The Places You Will Go." It's practically the same book, but less leaning on other Seuss titles. I'm aware that it isn't actually

written by the man, but I was no less disappointed. I read it once and didn't bother to again.

This book was not quite what I thought it was going to be. It tells a story using almost all of Dr. Seuss's characters, which is fun but almost too confusing. After reading the theory behind the book (reading to the unborn baby so they can associate comfort with the sound of reader's voice and story rhythm) I don't think it worked. It's Dr. Seuss style so it's expected to be tongue twister esk but it was just had to read at points, and I think this through off the flow of the story. I enjoyed the book, but it didn't meet my expectations.
