

I was going to save this book for next week's camping trip, but thought I'd just read a chapter or two when I first got it... Well, I ended up reading way too late into the night because I had to find out what happened! Moncado grabs the reader's interest right away, and doesn't let you go until the end. I always enjoy her books because they make the little girl dream of finding a prince (or princess) to love seem like a real possibility. Her characterizations and dialogue are very well done. The characters feel like good friends, and it's always fun to catch up with those from previous books as she weaves them into the new one. It's also always fun to find out what new plot ideas Moncado has dreamed up, and what twists you never suspected will take place. This book does not disappoint. If you haven't read *Dare You*, the prequel to this new series, you might want to do that first, but it's not absolutely necessary.

This was a great story of chance meetings, selflessness, devotion and sacrifice. Princess Astrid is grieving the loss of her husband, it's been almost 2 years, but it still hurts. Jordan is back on the island where he got a second chance at life. He is working hard to regain his strength, but he lands on a private beach to rest before he starts back to his cottage. He and Astrid meet and a friendship and attraction develop. He has no idea who she is and she is content to let this be a summer romance going nowhere. All this changes when some unexpected photos taken without their knowledge go viral. Nothing will ever be the same for either of them, but in time they see God's hand in bringing them together in a love for a lifetime.
