

SCIENCE COMICS: PLAGUES is a journey through history describing the howÃƒÃ¢Ã ¬Ã ¸s of infections, diseases and our immunity. Entertaining in such a way that I was also able to follow the educational aspect without getting bored or confused.Bubonic Plague and Yellow Fever are dropped into a host (so they believe) and promptly begin their attach on the body. As they proceed (unsuccessfully I might add) they are quickly interrupted by a white blood cell. Given that the white blood cell is there to fight off infection and disease, the depiction of the white blood cell is fitting ÃƒÃ¢Ã ¬Ã ¸ the cartoon character looks like a linebacker. Humour is sprinkled throughout the dialogueÃƒÃ¢Ã ¬Ã ¸ for example, when the white blood cell is describing both bubonic plague and yellow fever to Elena during a bit of a scuffle he says ÃƒÃ¢Ã ¬Ã ¸ÃƒÃ¢Ã ¬Ã ¸Ã “They have the critical thinking power of JelloÃƒÃ¢Ã ¬Ã ¸. The artwork is cartoony with the characters drawn with simplicity yet with just enough detail, capturing the individuality of each of the characters/diseases.I appreciated the glossary at the end of the book providing a concise and easily understood definitions of what was discussed throughout the book, with pictures. Good for visual learners.With the author presenting complex scientific concepts by using illustrations and humour, I was able to understand the concepts more easily and hopefully I will be able retain this information for a long period of time ÃƒÃ¢Ã ¸ÃœÃ ¸. I would like to think that if I had had this book available when studying these concepts in school, I would have understood and enjoyed the learning even more than I did.This book is for anyone who wishes to learn about plagues, infections, diseases in an entertaining and educational manner and enjoys comic books.
