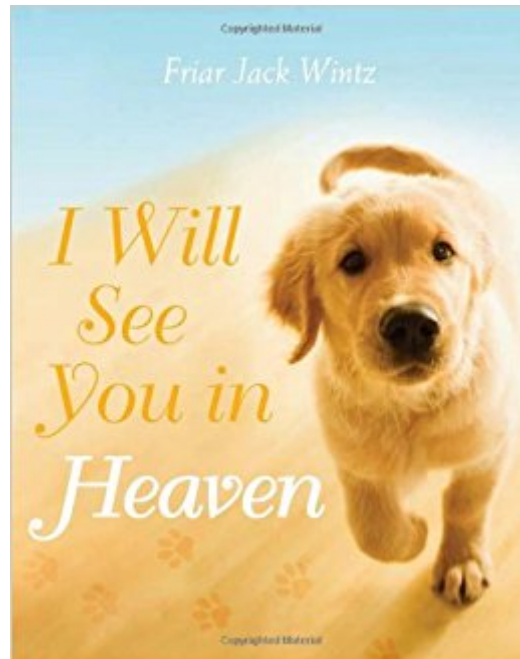

I bought this as a gift for a friend a few days after her cat died, and she has been comforted by it. I also got the original version for myself. Both are similar (I read both to compare). They are written by Father Jack Wintz, so it does focus on the Catholic perspective. It is not a lengthy book (about 110 pages), and an easy read. It gives a hopeful viewpoint on a difficult topic. I hope this has helped. Thank you.

This was a very sweet, very comforting little book for anyone who has lost a beloved pet. The book is short, can be read in about an hour, but it's worth the read.

My favorite dog is 12, at this time, with multiple health problems. I know there are fewer days ahead of us than there are behind us. While Fr. Jack's writings have not stopped my fears and tears, he did change my way of thinking. As a child, when my family's dog died while I was about 6-7, I asked my grandmother if she thought our dog was in heaven. She said "no" because animals do not have souls. I believed that for the next 45 years. I have no children, and have been divorced twice, so my dog is my only family. I have been praying so hard that I get to see him again. Then, I found this book. I am not Catholic, and have no affinity for Catholic saints, but I am Born Again. This book provides very coherent reasoning why all of creation will continue in paradise: Man is the only creature created on earth guilty of sin, and the Bible is God's handbook for Man. Salvation is meant for humans because we are the ones headed to Hell without it. I still have questions about some animals (fish, because the new earth will not have seas, and protozoa...what about them?), and I

would love to meet the author one day and ask him, but this book has provided the first glimmer of hope for me. Faith will have to carry on from there. If you are hurting over the loss of a beloved animal, read this. It helped me so much!

For years the Catholic church said animals have no souls. Finally Pope John Paul II stated yes they do! But when confronted with the afterlife issue, priests will either say we just don't know what happens to them, or the souls perish on death. When asked where scripture states that, they can't give you one, because it's not there. This book logically looks at some scripture and presents an obvious case that God loves them like he does us, and would not allow them to simply vanish from existence. That would be quite a cruel God and not the God we have come to know. My hat off for this brave and excellent book.

If anyone has doubt that the Lord doesn't love animals and uses them too for his good...read this book!!! It dispels all doubts. The Lord expects us to love and protect the animals we have been entrusted with and the ones we encounter who need help. I bought it for friends of mine who recently lost their 15 year old sheep dog/lab. Rusty was more than an animal...more like an Angel who touched many lives. This book helps prove it!!!
