Wonderful book on the beginning basics of knitting. I found it a month after I started teaching knitting to a group of 9-11 year old girls. I wish I had it in the beginning as most were struggling. It just wasn't coming easy. Then I found this book that starts the beginner knitting on circular needles. It let's the beginner concentrate just on the knit stitch. No working about dropping needles. It teaches both Continental and Throwing style of knitting. If you are going to teach someone how to knit get this book no matter what their age! I also recommend buying quality needles and yarn for the beginner.

I really like it. I feel it is organized better then the other kids knitting books I have and I love the spiral binding. I think this book with some size 10 /16 inch circular needles and some bulky yarn would make a great gift for someone wanting to learn to knit.

I am a huge fan of Susan B. Anderson's designs and all of her other books. I anticipated liking this book -- but it's even better than I expected it would be! I wish this book would have been available when I taught my nieces and nephews to knit over the years. It would have helped build their confidence to see every step broken down so clearly and illustrated so well. I'm really excited, though, that I'll have it to teach my own son and the younger nieces when they're ready to learn. The instructions and illustrations are all so clear, and it's arranged so that the projects progress naturally through the various skills needed to become a skilled knitter. The projects include hats, a scarf, a bracelet, and toys that kids will like to make for themselves or others. I'll probably make some of them myself. This book is very nicely done and a great value!

Don't let the title fool you, this is a great introductory book for all ages. I gifted a copy to a 60+ yo friend, and she was so grateful to have all the basics explained (yarn types, how to cast on, basic terms, etc.)

I've been teaching knitting to children for years, and this is by far the best source I've ever seen. It is well organized, has great methods and ideas and is fun. This should become the gold standard for knitting with kids. I love that it's called "workshop".

Susan B. Anderson is one of my favorite designers and she didn't let me down with this book either. Lots of fun patterns, easy to follow, lots of pics along the way as well as finished project. She rocks! Get this book - you won't be disappointed!
