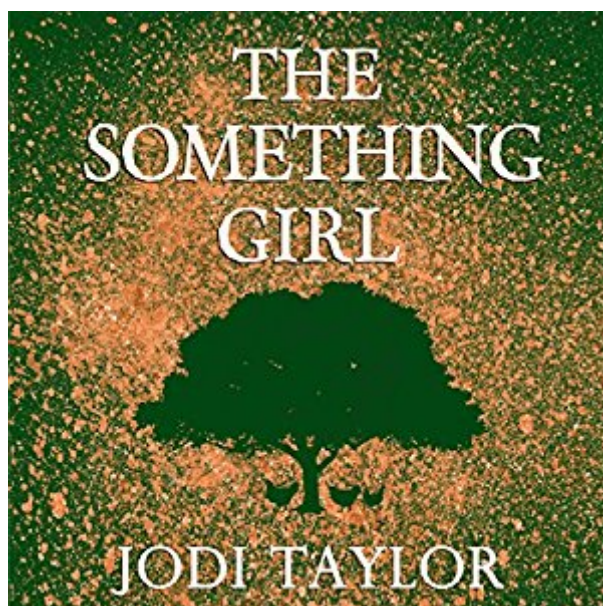


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The Something Girl: The Frogmorton Farm Series, Book 2
