

Who is Andi? A precocious 5 year who is soon going to be turning 6 and thinks she is now big enough to have a horse of her own, rather than her pokey little pony, Coco. The story is set in the 1870's so at a time when horses were valued as transportation, working aids etc. Andi lives on a ranch with her family and her chore is to pick up eggs each day. Unfortunately Henry the Eighth, the rooster, doesn't like Andi and so on this particular morning after declaring herself "big enough" Henry chases Andi and she ends up with smashed eggs all over her. (Our kids thought this was

hilarious as we live on a farm too and once in a while get a nasty rooster!) Will Andi come to appreciate Coco or will she continue to want a horse? Find out as Andi and her friend Riley, who is 8, head out for a ride - Andi on Coco and Riley on his horse, Midnight. This is a chapter book for independent readers or in our case, great as a read aloud for the whole family to enjoy. The activities, coloring sheets etc available on the author's website are SUPERB! Great lessons to learn in this book. Wholesome reading. HIGHLY RECOMMENDED from our house to yours!
